Weekly Conflict Summary November 1016, 2016

This week, pregovernment forces cleared opposition forces from DahyiAsalad, pushing front lines beyond the western edge of Aleppo city and consolidating gains made over the past two weeks. As pro government forces advanced, the governor of Alepprounceplans to create a patrol to stdpe high level looting in areas retaken from opposition forces immes of this sort have been difficult to manage as the frontline force in the wartorn city rely increasinglyon foreign militia, weakening centralized control over progovernment forces.

On November 13, prgovernment forces issued a-2dur ultimatum calling for opposition fighters to lay down theirarms and for civilians to leave oppositibeld areas before airstrikes resume. High intensity strikes resumed after the-2dur period elapsed, striking three hospitals in East Aleppo on November 16 and 17.

As the situation in East Aleppo continues to deteriorate, civilians have protested corruption among opposition leaders and demanded their removal. Demonstrators also stormed the opposition described center for aid distribution of Asbat-ablani, distributing the supplies to the people.
