The Senate candidates and political party representatives recognize and agreen/dicatatic elections require thatotershave the opportunityotmake an informed choice and to vote freely, without being subject todisinformation, domestic or foreign interference, fearque influence and intimidation.

The Senate candidates and political party representatives recognize and aguedeln deorgia law, voters have the right to cast their ballots by mail, through early insen voting, or through in-person voting on the January 5 runoff date.

The Senate candidates and political party representatives recognize and agreenthate that all votes are reported and counted accurately, the counting and canvassing processes will be open to accredite partypoll watchers and monitors who will conduct themselves professionally and in accordance with applicable Georgia law to monitor of ballots attabulating centers and precincts also are open to the public to nonpartisan observers.

The Senate candidates and political party representatives thereby agreemocouragerespect for these principles by:

- taking decisiveefforts to preventparty leaders, officials, candidates, and partymbers from acting contrary to these principles
- encouragingall eligible voters to register and to vote, and avoiding steps to inappropriately disenfranchise currently registered voters;
- encouraging voters to select the option casting a ballothat best suits their needs, assoto encourage maximum participation by Georgians in these elections;
- reassuringvoters that all voting procedures thorized by lawincluding voting by absentee ballot, are safe, secure, and reliable, harde built in checks and controls to ensure integrity of the elections and
- allowing the media to cover all aspects of candidates' election camparights elections
